**Administrative Assistant Jessica Foss** has regular office hours from 10:00 to NOON Monday through Friday.

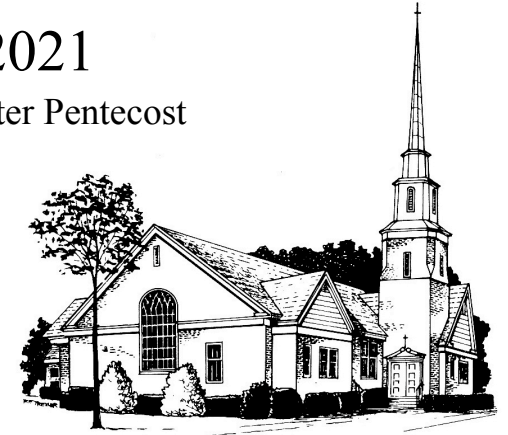

**Haitian Students.** We have been able to raise support for three Haitian students to go to school. This is one of the ways we are making a difference for a beloved nation beleaguered by tragedy.
