

Sermon and Prayer Notes

A Ministry Team Conference will be held on Saturday morning, February 26. Our speaker will be The Rev. Dr. Merrit Marsango, who will provide some vision as to how a ministry team lead church can do significant mission together. We will begin with breakfast in Fellowship Hall and continue in the Chapel.

Our Health Ministry is provided after worship on the last Sunday of the month. Professionals who are part of our congregation provide blood pressure screening after worship. Those who have health questions may also find help by asking one of our health professionals.

Grace Place ecumenical food pantry is located at Grace Lutheran Church. Any nonperishables are welcomed, especially ready to eat canned meals, stuffing mix (like Stovetop), cake mixes, soups and all kinds of condiments. There is also a need for toiletry items like soap, toothpaste and paper goods.

This group explores following Jesus from a biblical point of view and seeks to make it practical to influence our community towards Kingdom living.
