Grace Place Food Pantry Needs Our Help! – Their food pantry is out of many items. We will be collecting grocery store gift cards, condiments, canned goods, spaghetti sauce, sugar, flour, simple cake/brownie mixes, salad dressings, canned soups, peanut butter, jelly/jam, bread, rolls, crackers, coffee, snacks, granola bars, instant oatmeal/cereal, shampoo, conditioner, body wash, soap, and toothpaste. A collection box is located in our fellowship hall and another is located outside (by the rear entrance of the education center).
